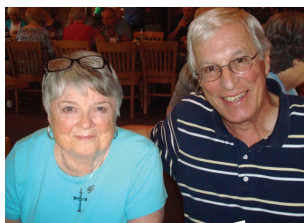
I have been blessed with friendships formed at church and as I grow older I appreciate all those who do so much at the church.
